I think it's great. I've just got a few minor suggestions to reduce the word count on the front page if you don't mind.

My suggested version is:

In Victoria, sex work is only legal if it takes place within certain areas, such as industrial precincts, (Sex Work Act 1994).

The Victorian Government, through the Sex Work Decriminalisation Bill, is seeking to expand where sex work can legally operate. Under the changes, sex work will be allowed to operate on public streets, in residential, retail and commercial areas.

Council holds concerns that the proposed changes will negatively impact the community, especially businesses, families and children.

Council is also concerned that the proposals will not achieve the worthy goal of increased safety for sex workers and will instead result in reduced police, health and counselling resources for sex workers.

Council is of the view that the Government's consultation process for these proposed changes was insufficient. Whilst Council has no authority in relation to this issue, we believe it is our duty to make sure the voice of our community is heard and so we are inviting you to complete a brief survey.


