I had a meeting with **and a set of** and told them what I wanted and asked for advice around wording, and they both said they'd get back to me.

They did, with some general comments, but they were very vague and so I had wanted to send them my draft first. All I wanted was a stream of funding available to any sex workers in Melton who decide they want to leave the industry, because according to the (many, many, many) government submissions I read (most of whom supported the legislation) there is a longstanding consensus that it is both difficult and dangerous to leave sex work when a person wants to, due to lack of emergency housing and appropriate mental health resources. So I was seeking some advice from the officers who'd be impacted.

The second idea was a simple one, for a place in Diggers Rest where I could advocate for a 'free to the public' small scale sporting infrastructure project, such as a basketball court or a tennis court or something like that, that people don't need to pay fees to a club to use.

I received some vague information, but was very unsure of how to word my proposals that I'd put to them using what they gave me.

It would be really good to have a chat, because I'd very much like to put them in- I just wanted more specific advice around wording them and wasn't able to do that because the final week of my holidays were interrupted by inability to access internet.
