Hi Cr Deeming,

I have just replied to your email sent at 4.27pm on Saturday this weekend.

Your NOM raises complex legal questions which I have been diligently considering since it was first raised and voted on by Council.

I appreciate you are interested in hearing back in respect of it and I am working as hard as I can to this end but to email a Council Officer in the middle of a long weekend and then escalate it to the Mayor and Deputy Mayor when it isn't responded to before the end of the same long weekend seems premature and unnecessary to me.

I am currently doing my absolute best whilst I am 7 staff short in my team to service the entirety of Council in the extremely busy areas of legal services, governance, and risk (as is evidenced by me working on a public holiday and most days until well after 10pm) and this kind of escalation and the criticism of me implied in it to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and CEO (for the second time in a single weekend) puts unnecessary pressure on me to prioritise your work over a multitude of other matters more urgent matters which you are unaware of.

I believe you have acted unfairly towards me in writing to the Mayor and Deputy Mayor (and twice to the CEO) in these circumstances, without even giving me the benefit of the long weekend within which to respond to your email sent late on Saturday afternoon, and I am both surprised and disappointed that you have done so to be honest.

A copy of my earlier reply is attached for the benefit of the Mayor and the Deputy Mayor also, now that they have been made aware of your dissatisfaction with the speed of my reply.

I will continue to endeavour to finalise the report responding to your NOM as soon as I can (aiming for the June meeting as I indicated in my email to you sent a short time ago), noting my need to triage and balance all of my numerous work commitments based on urgency due to the significant resourcing deficiencies in my team at present.
